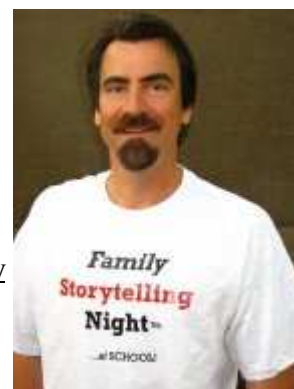


How I got 75 Families Speaking 14 Different Languages (all in the same room at the same time!) Telling Stories to Each Other— and Laughing So Hard Their Eyes Watered and Sides Ached

People are amazed when I tell them about my Family Storytelling Night® success on the Island of Saipan in February, 2007 (a great place to visit in winter, I must say!) Parents speaking **14 different languages** laughed so hard there were **tears** in their eyes (and in my eyes, too). Have you ever laughed that hard?

Put it this way – the phrase, “*A good time was had by all,*” doesn’t even come close to describing the FUN people had telling stories in Saipan!

I was *invited* by the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Public School System to train educators on parent involvement and literacy enhancement and I facilitated a **Family Storytelling Night®** for a diverse group of parents and children – who were invited by ELL/ESL specialists, adult education teachers, early childhood educators, and child-and-family program professionals.

“Wow! How’d You Do That?”

A **Family Literacy** and ELL program director in Denver asked me, “**How did you do that?**” For starters, I explained, the parents worked in the garment industry. (They’d come to Saipan from several countries for the work – that’s why so many languages were spoken.) Then I told her HOW I did it:

Even though only 40% of the Saipan families spoke English, *everybody* in the room **strived to find the words** (in English) to explain their “family stories.” And everyone listened all-the-more intently than they normally would...because they REALLY WANTED to hear the stories other families were telling.

That’s how it ALWAYS goes! Isn’t that interesting?

The other neat thing about the Saipan event (and all Family Storytelling Night® events I’ve done where there are English Language Learners present), is that everyone strives to speak their **best English** – their “second language” – as they really “reach” to be understood in the fun, engaging context of the evening’s storytelling.

Here’s what happens: An “*I can do this!*” mind-set fills the room, and people who are normally quiet, shy, and un-involved are READY and EAGER to tell their stories!

Parents pull out all the stops, and use as much English as they can muster. They strive with great excitement to use English (and their native language, too) to convey the meaning behind their story. And they feel a sense of REWARD when everyone “gets it” – “gets” their story. They also get to hear their story told in English, and they become the person nodding their head and smiling widely. Can you picture their enthusiasm?
